KENTUCKY ARMY NATIONAL GUARD WORKSHOP (COUNSELOR CAREER PROGRESSION)

The Kentucky National Guard's 2010 Three-Hour Extreme Workshop will focus on empowering counselors with the knowledge of how the National Guard can support Academic, Career, and Personal/Social development of all students. We will call this workshop "The Guard Experience", which will highlight a few of our programs that may be used to support the academic development of all students.

Heritage Outreach Program {an interactive presentation}- Heritage Outreach tells the story of the nation's dedication to promoting independence and freedom by delving into the cultures, ideas, and practices of America's military history. This four-part program is illustrated with photographs, maps and historical artifacts.

High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle (HUMVEE) School Program - A rare opportunity for a hands-on exciting and memorable educational experience, the HUMVEE School Program informs students about technical career paths, while offering an up-close and personal look at a HUMVEE. For students interested in automotive careers, learning about HUMVEE history and technology is a unique educational experience.

"You Can" School Program - An award-winning public service offered by the National Guard, these classroom presentations help students develop necessary life skills in order to have successful futures and accomplish great things. The program offers more than 36 motivational presentations, organized into the following categories: Health and Social Well-Being, Life Betterment, and Discovery and Disaster Preparation. These classroom presentations are being enhanced and new presentations are being added frequently. New presentations that have been added are: Test Taking, Interviewing, Financial Aid (FAFSA), and Military Awareness I & II.

Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) & Career Exploration Program - These two programs can help your students move towards finding a career that is right for them. They will benefit from the program whether they plan to pursue furthering their education after high school or entering the workforce. These two programs are designed to help students with the following: * Learn more about themselves and the world of work. *Explore occupations in line with their interests and skills. * Develop an effective strategy to recognize a number of realistic career goals. * In addition, the ASVAB can be used as a pre-test for the ACT or SAT.
